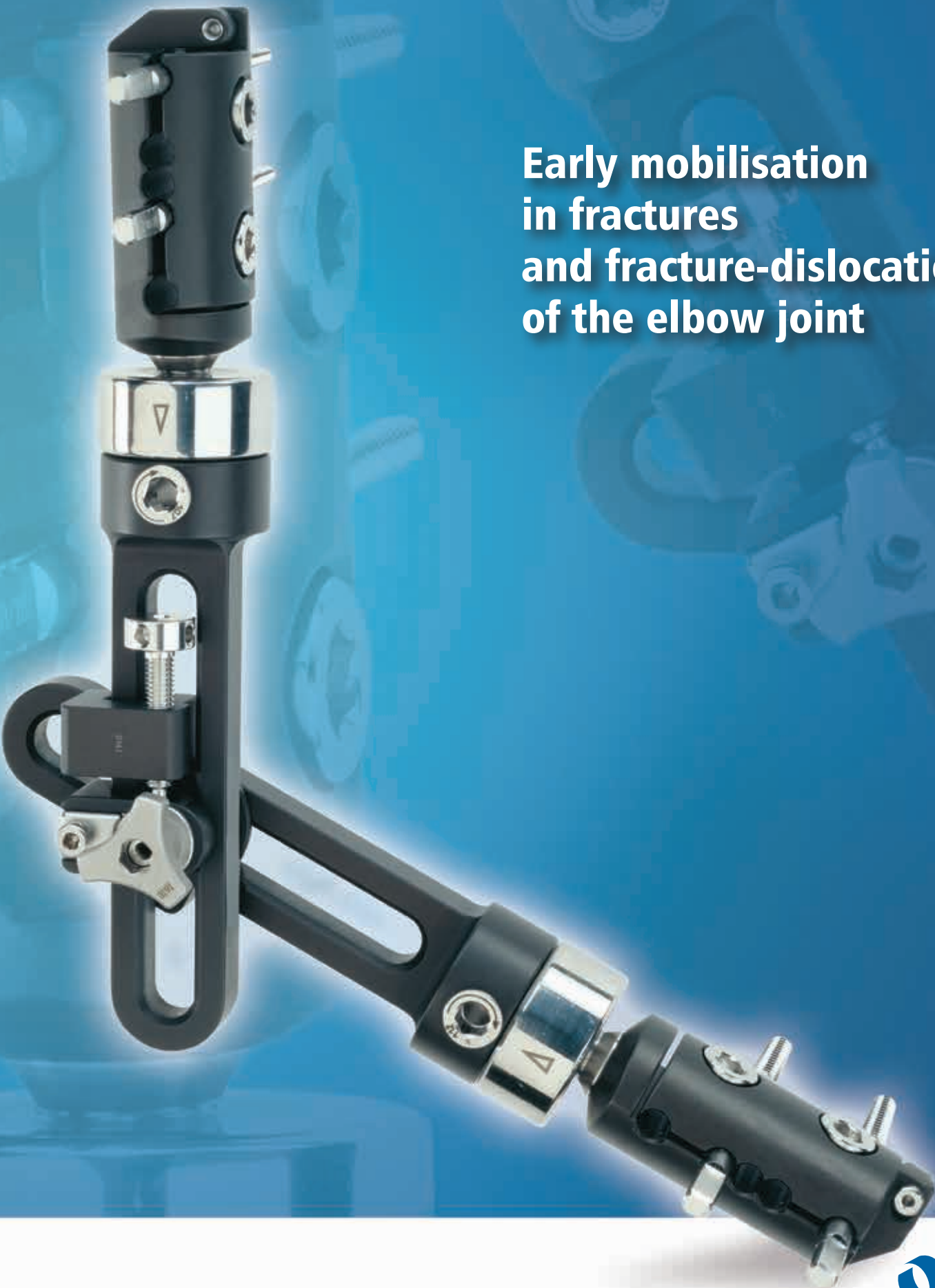

Early mobilisation in fractures and fracture-dislocations of the elbow joint



ORTHOFIX®



Stable, controlled movement round the axis of rotation of the elbow joint

Immediate pronation and supination

Early flexion and extension

Well tolerated by the patient

Controlled distraction of the joint possible

Extended Range Clamp

increases choice of angle of ulnar screws



Also indicated for the treatment of stiff elbows

- Intra-articular fractures
- Fracture-dislocations requiring further stabilisation after treatment
- Post-traumatic stiffness
